

Students must be proficient in handling and loading their handguns. (*know where the safety and magazine release is and able to load their own magazines*)

This IS NOT a beginner class

Required equipment for handgun 201:

*Medium to Large frame Semi Auto handgun in 9mm or larger with all factory safeties in place. (No pocket pistols like: Ruger LCP, LC9, Micro 380, S&W Bodyguard, Sig P238, Walther PPS, ect)

*Holsters must be outside the belt, correctly fit the weapon, completely cover the trigger guard, remain open when the weapon is removed, not allow the weapon to cover the shooter's body, and not have a trigger guard retention device (such as the Blackhawk Serpa model and others). NO thigh rigs, cross-draw or with more than a 15 degree forward cant – (FBI style holsters) I can defeat the trigger guard retention device for the class if needed.

*A minimum of three magazines and two single or one double magazine pouch is recommended. Magazine pouches worn on the belt on the side opposite the handgun. (support side)

*Electronic hearing protection is mandatory. (electronic muffs) Rentals available.

*Wrap around eye protection.

*Ball cap or other brimmed hat.

*Ammunition must be factory new. No reloads.

*Minimum 300 rounds required for the class. Ammo available on site.

*Classes are 9am – 4pm with one hour for a provided lunch.
